GET SHOES REMOVED IN THE FALL BEFORE THE FIRST BIG SNOW THEY WILL HAVE TROUBLE WALKING IF THEY GET BALLED UP FROM A LOT OF SNOW FALL. IF THEY NEED SNOW SHOES BRONINE CLEATS YOU CAN ONLY GET THEM ON THE FRONT FEET ONLY, TO DANGEROUS IF THEY WERE TO KICK ANOTHER HORSE WITH THEM ON THE BACK FEET.

PICK HOOVES - OFTEN WHEN NEEDED, CHECK FOR ROCKS. EXPECIALLY IF A HORSE ACTS SORE OR LAME CHECK HOOK AREA FIRST, THEN CHECK FOR SWOOLEN AREAS, HEAT IN LEGS

IF LAME I WOULD CONTACT FARRIER/BLACKSMITH FIRST BEFORE YOUR VET, COMMON PROBLEMS ARE IN HOOF/FOOT BRUISING OR A POSSIBLE ABSESS WHICH A FARRIER WILL TRY TO DIG OUT WITH PROPER FARRIER TOOLS, THEY WILL TELL YOU TO CONTACT A VET AFTER THAT OR NOT IF STILL NEEDED

TRAIL MANNERS

- 1. Do not canter past another horse. Trot up and ask permission to pass.
- 2. Put a ribbon in the tail of a horse that kicks.
- 3. Pick up litter & Don't litter/no cigarette butts
- 4. Do not weave in and out of line of riders.
- 5. Do not trot or canter on hard surface roads.
- 6. The whole group should ride on the same side of the road.
- 7. Stop if someone ahead has trouble.
- 8. Canter only in an area with no overhanging branches.
- 9. Never tie to a tree, use a picket line.

EQUIPMENT FOR TRAIL RIDE

Halter and lead rope
 Tent or camper for sleeping

2. Lariat or other rope 12. Sleeping bags

3. Saddlebags or other bag

13. Saddle, bridle, blanket etc.

4. Canteen or other water container
5. Raincoat or poncho
14. Utensils and food for eating
15. First aid materials for horse

6. Mosquito repellent 16. Horse feed
7. Jacket or sweatshirt 17. Hoof pick

8. Flashlight (for night riding) 18. Pail for horse

9. Sunburn repellent (if needed) 19. Camera would be nice

10. Band-aids 20. Boots for riding

CARE OF HORSE ON TRAIL RIDE

1. Feed plenty of salt.

2. If horse comes into camp hot, cool and feed him. Do not water for at least two hours.

3. Do not take your horse into stream or lake unless it has been OK'd first.

4. Do not canter on hot, muddy days.

5. Most horses need shoes in front for long trail rides. (several days)

6. Horses should be in good physical condition

7. Horse blankets are desirable at night in cold weather

8. Bring extra saddle blankets and girths. Alternate each day. (several day ride)

9. Insect repellents during buggy seasons

10. Approach horse watering places with caution unless they are marked as safe watering holes. Many lakes and streams are surrounded by soft and boggy ground that could mire a horse.

11. When watering horses in streams, be careful to approach where you will not break down the river

12. Tethering your horse and their continued safety and security will be up to you. Bring halter, tie ropes and a saddle rope to be used as a picket line which will keep your horse securely tied. Let's prevent accidents and injury.

13. Do not litter

14. Relax-have a good time and use good horse sense.

15. GOOD IDEA TO TAKE A RAIN SLICKER & REFECTIVE CLOTHING OR ITENS FOR YOUR HORSE TO WEAR IF IT BECOMES DARK OR RIDING IN THE EVENING HOURS

RULES

- 1. Parent permission slip required to be turned into leaders; then Chairmen upon arrival at the ride.
- 2. No one is to leave campsite without permission.
- 3. Members will be responsible to any leader if parents are not present.
- 4. Please attend Church Service; or if not, please be quiet for those who do attend.
- 5. Do not leave the trail or group without permission of leader.
- 6. Use good "Horse Sense" in riding and camping.

All participants will conduct themselves in a courteous manner and observe the Trail rules.
